DEATH TAKES WILLIAM E SHAMBAUGH, PIONEER IOWA PARMER.... The Des Meines Regeiter of December 2 carried the following item- " William E Shambaugh, 72, who had been a farmer living near Booneville, lows for many years, died Early Wednesday morning, following an illness of 14 months. He was born near Beoneville. The survivors are: his wife, new living at Winterset; two daughters. Mrs Alvin Meyers of Van Meter, Iowa and Mrs Mary Ackerman of Los Angeles, California: five sons, PFC Ralph Shambaugh, Hart Mountain, Wyo., Sgt. Robert Shambaugh, Comp White. Ores. Bubert Shembaugh, second class motor mechanics mate in the Coast Guard, New York, N Y., Phil Shambaugh of Des Moines and Bussell Shambaugh of Houston, Texas, together with Beven grandchildren. " Mr. Shambaugh was the oldest con and fourth child of Adam H and Mary Jane Shambaugh and was born Sept. 28, 1871. Surving, also, are three brothers and one sister. Original and Lloyd who live on farms near Booneville. Scott of Houston, Texas and our one News editor, Mrs Lois Castleberry of Houston. JOHN SHAMBAUGH , SON OF DANIEL SHAMBAUGH OF VIRGINIA

This is perhaps the hardest assignment that I have been given thus far, due to the fact that I do not know very much about John Shambaugh, son of Daniel Shambaugh. Because I have been able to get some information having found the bible of Catherine Shambaugh Pingley, daughter of John, which had not hitherto been located it has been thought that I have the most information about this gentlemen of any of the editors and I will do my best. Really, I consider this a special privilege because I am branching out into a field outside of my own line. John of the information which follows has been previously given in the News-Letter and I am truly sorry that I do not have much that is new to add. For the previous article I refer you to the December 1941 News-Letter.

John Shambaugh, son of Daniel Shambaugh, married Rebecca Kendrick on Dec. 24, 1804 (Marriage Register Book No. 1-Front Royal, Va.) To them were bern the following children as recorded in Catherine Shambaugh Pingley's Bible:

John Shambaugh was born December 6, 1805

Elisaan Shambaugh was born August 21, 1807

Catherine Shambaugh was born October 15, 1809

Samuel Shambaugh was born May , 1811

Josephn Shambaugh was born October 9, 1812

Daniel Shambaugh was born March 9, 1814

Mary Jane Shambaugh was born July 8, 1816

Rebeccs Shambaugh was born February 8, 1818

Catherine Pingley died March 35, 1870, aged 51 years 5 me 10 days David Pingley died December 15, 1891, aged 84 years 8 me 15 days

This Bible is now in the possession of Mrs Certis Pincies as Midd Pingley, who lives on Kings Street, Straeburg, Vincials, A. 77

John Shambauch died prior to 1836, the year of the death of his father Daniel, for the Children obneching decembed, were mentioned in his will.

* and **.. Were these two Daniels the same person ? If so, why the difference in marriage dates and why two entries? It would seem strage that there should be two Daniel Shambaughs and two Mary Klines.

***Mary Jane Shambaugh married her opusin, but died very moon after and it buried in the old Shambaugh cometary.

After the death of John Shambeugh a guardian was appointed for the children in the person of Jenes H Shambaugh. The Court records in 1831 shew an account of Marry Jene and Rebecca Shambaugh, erphans with Jenes H Shambaugh and this would show that both John and his wife had probably died previous to Nov.13, 1831. Further, we find that on Nov. 5, 1832 \$5.00 was cent to Kentucky to pay taxes on John's estate there. At Court held for Frederick County January 4, 1836 this Guardianship account of Mary Jene and Rebecca with Jenes H Shambaugh was produced, examined, and ordered to be vasated. F & Tidball signed for the County.

I shall mention the descendents of John Shambaugh and his wife insofar as Ilknew them. Beginning with Eliza Ann Shambaugh Holmes, there is Mrs M E Godlove, a granddaughter, Mrs Godlove is quite interested in the Shambaugh history but was unable to tell me very much of her own family history. This, I think, was due in part to the early death of Eliza Ann's parents. Mrs Godlove lives in Wheatfield, Virginia and I enjoyed my visit with her in 1942 very much.

Cetherine Shambaugh Fingley is represented by the following persons whom I have met! Miss Mamie Fingley, of Lebanon Church, Va., Mrs Gertie Fingley, the widow of Edd Fingley whom I have already mentioned! Mr. Lee Fingley of near Wheat field, Virginia and Mr. Frank Fingley of Junior, West Virginia.

Daniel Shambaugh, son of John Shambaugh, had a number of children, but as I had rather a full artile on his family in the News-Letter of December 1941 I will not give you mere at this time except to mention the widow of Daniel Kline Shambaugh, grandson of John Shambaugh. Not having heard to the contrary I believe her to be still living at the home of her son, Rev. Elmer Clinton Shambaugh, a retired Methodist minister at Ada, Chio. She was born Sept. 29, 1843 and was 100 years ald this past September. She is a lovely person and a gentlewomen. I described my visit with her in the article previously referred to.

Rebecca Shambangh Peery's descendents are perhaps much better known to me for I have had the keen pleasure of several visits with the members of the Eline family in Virginia. I should like to give you a little more of their history. The children of Watson and Rebecca Shambangh Peerys were Eliza Jane, who married Samuel Hammeck: Charles Milton, who married Mark Kline. Their son, James Eline seems to have married a Polly Shambangh: Catherine died young, aged 14 years: Jeneryy Jenewieve married Snewden B. Kline: and of Philip and Calvin Winfield I have no information other than their names.

The children of Jenervy Jenevieve Peery and Snowden B. Iline are, Little Duncan Kline who is superintendent of schools at Winchester, Virginia; Lillian, Secessed; Lucy, wife-of Mrs S B Frice of Winchester, Virginia; Marvin, decessed, and the Misses Mamie, Kithe and Grack, all at home in Winchester, Virginia. I have visited in the homes of these very distant cousins and enjoyed very much the house spent with them. My most recent visit was in October of the present year as I was on my way to Union County, Pennsylvania. I feel that probably they can give us much more of the history of this fine branch of our family.

In closing this article I want to say that it was a great disappointment to me sot to have gotten to see others of my Virginia commine whom I met in 1941. This latest trip could not be made my car because of gas rationing and to get off the main highways was next to impossible. It is my hope that, when this terrible war is but a memory, I can again yiall Virginia and renew the former contacts.
